Council Chairman Vincent C. Gray announces a public hearing by the Committee of the Whole on Bill 17-552, the "Closing of a Public Alley in Square 700, S.O. 07-9626, Act of 2007." The public hearing is scheduled for Monday, February 25, 2008, at 2:00 p.m., in Room 123 of the John A. Wilson Building, 1350 Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W.

Bill 17-552, introduced by Councilmember Wells, would close a public alley in Square 700, bounded by M, Half, N and South Capitol Streets, S.E., in Ward 6. The applicant, Monument Realty, requests the closure to facilitate the development of a 130 foot tall residential building with ground floor retail and underground parking.
