Bill 17-28, introduced by Councilmembers Brown, Schwartz and Barry, would authorize the installation of LED message boards on the outside front wall of the John A. Wilson Building and the Washington Nationals ballpark to display the dollar amount of federal taxes paid by District of Columbia residents.
